REPORTING POSITIVE CASES OF COVID-19 IN THE HOLIDAYS

Public Health consider COVID positive people 'infectious' for 2 days prior to their symptoms starting (or if asymptomatic, 2 days prior to the date of their positive test).

Therefore, please utilise the information below regarding any possible cases which should occur after we break up.
