We ended the week last week with a poignant Remembrance service. The children made some beautiful poppies and poems, which we displayed around the school grounds. Just before 11, we gathered outside each building, facing our poppies and listened to the music of the Military Wives, before The Last Post signalled the start of our silence. We were all incredibly proud of how respectful and thoughtful our children were during this time of remembrance.



This week is Anti-Bullying week across the country.
