



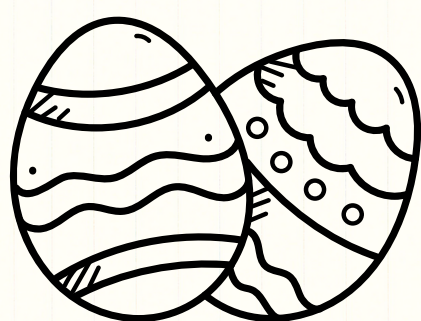

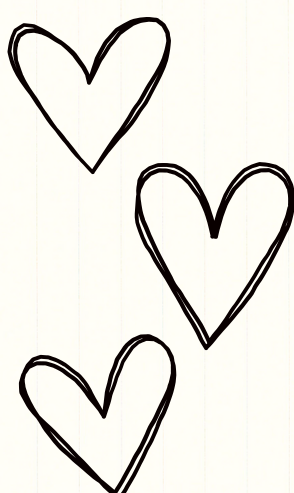


EASTER HOLIDAYS

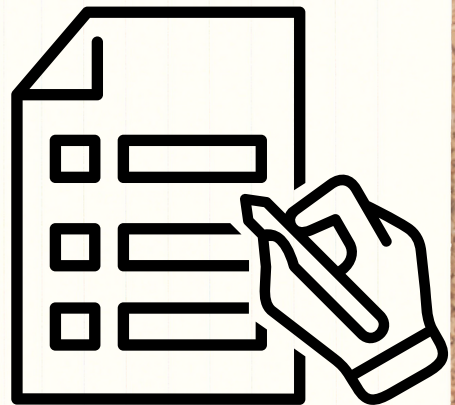

Well done to 5RD who achieved 99.62% attendance last week. Whole school attendance rose to 96.16% which is close to our 97% target.

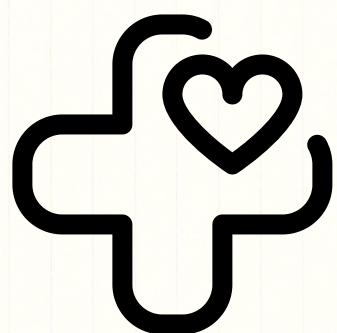


LATENESS

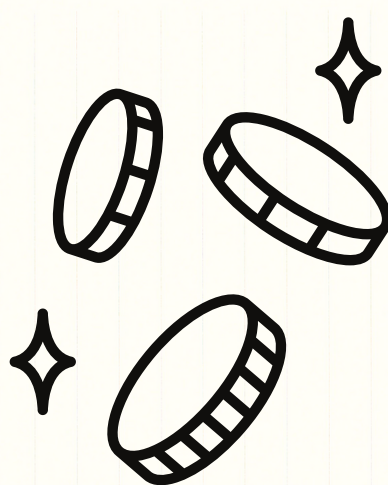
A test message has been sent out via the School jotter app to all parents/carers of children attending the PGL trip.

Please note that we have a member of staff who is severely allergic to lavender (including the scent) Please DO NOT pack any lavender scented items



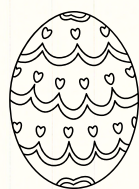
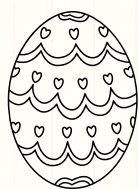

On Friday 22nd March there will be an Easter egg raffle.

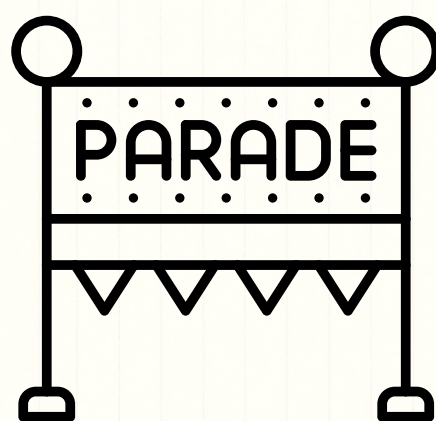
Children can bring money in to buy tickets from Monday 18th.
