




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
## EASTER HOLIDAYS








#### **ATTENDANCE**




## EASTER FREE SCHOOL MEAL VOUCHERS

Families will need to select their chosen supermarket before the vouchers will be sent.
















#### YEAR 5 PGL

This money will not be accepted on the day.







On Thursday 21st March Parents from EY and Year 1 are invited in for our Easter Bonnet parade. We will open the top gate at 2.45pm for access to the parade.












The main driving gate on Towers Drive is closed between 8.30-8.55am and 3.05-3.35pm.
