




<u>MAY BANK HOLIDAY</u> School will be closed on Monday 6th May for the bank holiday.

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

PGL RESIDENTIAL 2025



Yesterday we launched a new school lunch menu. This is on a three week rotation. and a copy of the menu can be found under the Parents tab on the school website.


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




The main driving gate on Towers Drive is closed between 8.30-8.55am and 3.05-3.35pm.
