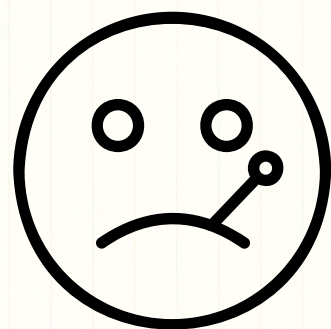

peanuts or nuts.

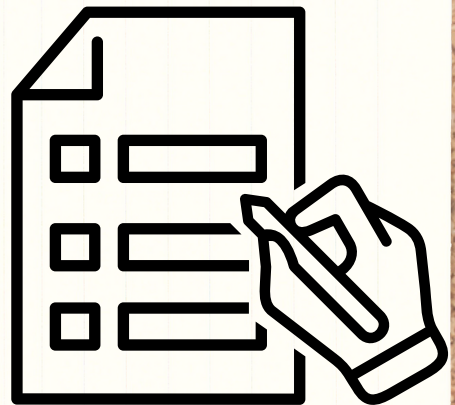

For all students wishing to attend PGL in 2025 the deposit is now live on ParentPay.

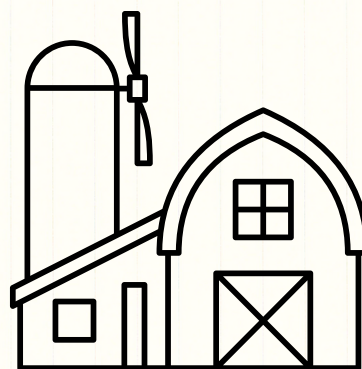

This is on a three week rotation. and a copy of the menu can be found under the Parents tab on the school website.

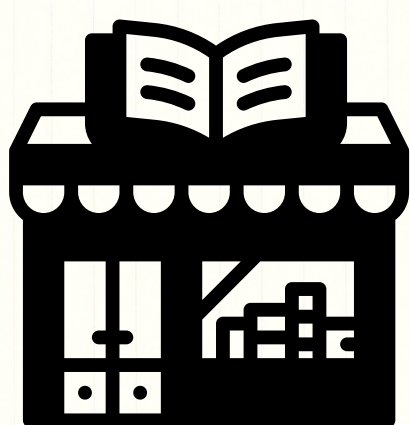
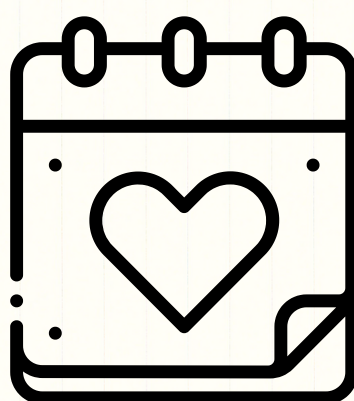
